We did not stay silent for tragedy in Somalia

Around 24-ton medicine and medical supply provided by Ministry of Health arrived at Somalia with "Sebat" Humanitarian Aid Ship of Red Crescent of Turkey on June 15, 2017 on the directions of President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan as part of humanitarian aid activities carried out within the scope of "Be Humanity's Hope" initiated for the humanitarian crisis that occurred due to the drought in East Africa especially in Somalia and Yemen.

On the other hand, the pediatric patients whose treatments continue at Mogadishu-Somalia Turkey Recep Tayyip Erdoğan Training and Research Hospital is making progress. The treatments of 195 children treated because of malnutrition and

excessive dehydration during the cholera epidemic at Baydoa region continues under the supervision of the team in the presidency of infectious diseases specialist Dr. Kubilay Yapıcı Mogadishu-Somalia Turkey Recep Erdoğan Training and Research Hospital. Two doctors and two nurses will continue to deliver medical services for 10-day periods in turn about the epidemic and also Turkish Hospital will cover the expenses of transfer and treatment for the patients who need further treatment.

The patients and the attendants are now delivered food at the field kitchen established in the hospital garden in Baydoa region with the contributions of Turkish health personnel working at the hospital in the capital Mogadishu.
